**MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING REGARDING FIRE MANAGEMENT
(ACKNOWLEDGMENT OF PARTICIPATION)**

THIS AGREEMENT is entered into for the purpose of including the above-described private real property in the Moffat County Wildland Fire and Fuel Management Plan. By executing this Agreement, I acknowledge the following:

- 1) I am authorized to make fire management decisions for the above-described property and I am voluntarily participating in the Moffat County Wildland Fire and Fuel Management Plan; and
- 2) The attached parcel summary represents my desires concerning vegetation treatments and naturally ignited fire management on the above-described property; and
- 3) I understand I have all authority allowed by state and federal law to implement vegetation treatments on my property. Nothing in the Moffat County Wildland Fire and Fuel Management Plan nor this Memorandum of Understanding shall give any agency, organization, or individual the ability to implement vegetation treatments on my property without my explicit cooperation and consent; and
- 4) If I have requested that naturally ignited fires be allowed to burn on my private land, I acknowledge that every effort will be made to allow this; however, the parties responsible (e.g. Moffat County Sheriff) for the management of naturally ignited fires on private property may elect to suppress them. Reasons that fires may be suppressed include, but are not limited to, availability of fire management resources, weather conditions, projected likelihood of the fire remaining within area of prescription, and protection of life and property; and
- 5) I understand that that the Moffat County Wildland Fire and Fuel Management Plan is continually evolving and addresses dynamic and ever-changing issues, and if at any time in the future I wish to amend or alter the fire management recommendations involving my property, I will notify the Moffat County Commissioners in writing at 221 West Victory Way, Craig, CO 81625 of the specific amendments or alterations to my Management Situation. The Moffat County Commissioners will notify appropriate wildland fire parties (e.g. Moffat County Sheriff) of such amendments within 10 working days after receipt of the amendments. Until specific amendments or alterations to my parcel summary are received by the Moffat County Commissioners and appropriate parties have been notified, the above-described parcel summary shall remain active.

I have read and fully understand the contents of this Memorandum of Understanding and have chosen to voluntarily participate in the Moffat County Wildland Fire and Fuel Management Plan, pursuant to C.R.S., 30-11-124(4).
