Land Cover Description:

Ten percent of the parcel is wheat fields and 30 percent is hay meadow. Forty percent of the parcel is a combination of sagebrush and grass, with the sagebrush varying from sparse on ridges to tall and dense in valley bottoms. There are scattered junipers on 5 percent of the parcel and sparse to moderately dense oakbrush on the remaining 15 percent of the parcel.

Land Use:

Part of the parcel is used for agriculture (wheat and hay) and the rest of the parcel is used for livestock grazing.

Fuel Models:

Slope:

Sixty percent of the parcel has mild slopes, 30 percent has moderate slopes, and 10 percent has steep slopes.

Aspect:

Aspect on this parcel is predominately west (70 percent) with small flat areas (10 percent), areas of north aspect (10 percent), and areas of south aspect (10 percent).

FIRE MANAGEMENT OBJECTIVES

The landowner chose Fire Management Category C to allow for options in the future. He may or may not want wildland fires to burn, depending on the year, time of year, condition of the range, etc.

Constraints and Priorities for Fire and Fuel Management:

House, barn, etc. are on a small (5 acre) parcel (0306011500060) within this larger parcel and need to be protected. Protect fences to the extent possible. The landowner is currently transferring an adjacent 41-acre parcel to his son (Chad Lawton). The house and improvements on this parcel should be protected at all times.
